Salary and conditions

The post of Development Officer is full time (37.5 hours per week). The gross salary is £28,000 to £38,000 per year subject to experience. The role is based in London and remote working is possible.

If you are currently or recently employed, please include your present or most recent salary, and your contractual notice period. Please explain any significant gaps (e.g. as a result of parenting/caring roles, career-breaks, self-employment, etc) including relevant skills/experience gained during these periods.
- An explanation of why you would like the job and how you meet the requirements of the Job Description.
- The names and contact details of two referees able to confirm the information in your application and ideally also able to comment on your relevant professional/voluntary experience, who may be contacted if you are short-listed. We will not contact your referees without informing you first.
